Ken Solberg Psy.D. faculty retires

Kenneth Solberg, Ph.D., has worked on and off for Saint Mary's since 1968. Dr. Solberg established the Psy.D. Program at Saint Mary's; and served as its Director from 2009-2016. Earlier in his career, Dr. Solberg taught for 18 years in the undergraduate Psychology department at Saint Mary's in Winona. He retired in January 2021 as a half-time core faculty member in the Psy.D. Program and now holds the title of professor emeritus. Dr. Solberg created a research scholarship fund which has been renamed the [Kenneth Solberg Dissertation Research Fund](#) in his honor. He was previously honored for his contributions to the field of mental health.
