### Building a Better Winona

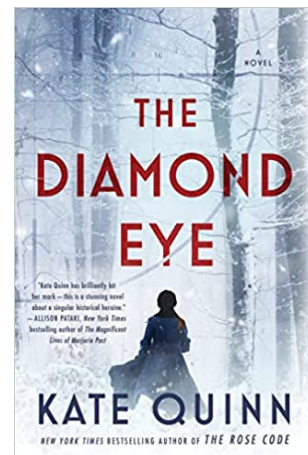
